### RULES AND PROCEDURES

#### ELIGIBILITY

1. APPLICANTS MUST BE EITHER:
  - A MEMBER OF THE ATU IN GOOD STANDING;
  - THE CHILD (WHETHER NATURAL OR LEGALLY ADOPTED) OR STEPCHILD OF A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING, OR OF A DECEASED MEMBER WHO WAS IN GOOD STANDING AT THE TIME OF HIS OR HER DEATH;
  - A GRANDCHILD (WHETHER NATURAL OR LEGALLY ADOPTED) OF A MEMBER OF THE ATU IN GOOD STANDING, OR OF A DECEASED MEMBER WHO WAS IN GOOD STANDING AT THE TIME OF HIS OR HER DEATH
  
2. APPLICANTS MUST BE HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS PLANNING TO ENTER COLLEGE (OR TECHNICAL OR VOCATIONAL POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL) FOR THE FIRST TIME FOLLOWING GRADUATION DURING THE 2018 - 2019 SCHOOL YEAR, OR PREVIOUS HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES THAT HAVE NEVER ATTENDED COLLEGE.
  
3. ATU SCHOLARSHIPS ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO THE FOLLOWING PERSONS:
  - THOSE WHO DO NOT INTEND TO WORK WITHOUT INTERRUPTION TOWARD A BACHELOR DEGREE OR GRADUATION FROM A TECHNICAL OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL,
  - THOSE WHO ARE ATTENDING OR HAVE ALREADY ATTENDED COLLEGE, TECHNICAL OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL;
  - SPOUSES OF MEMBERS;
  - ATU INTERNATIONAL OFFICERS, INTERNATIONAL REPRESENTATIVES, STAFF AND OTHER EMPLOYEES OR THEIR DEPENDENTS; OR
  - THOSE WHO ARE FULLY FUNDED FOR TUITION, FEES, AND BOOKS FROM OTHER SOURCES.
